Feedback Forms/End Raffle

We reviewed the 22 feedback forms from the conference as well as the results of the survey members e-mailed back to Jack last month. We discussed how to get more feedback from the conference. Results: We decided to have an afternoon raffle at the end of the last session, as we did a year ago. Instead of winning free registration next year, which doesn't mean much for those whose attendance is paid for by their school, we decided on a "cooler" prize, like a small CD/tape boom box that a teacher can take to any classroom or just use at home.

Lunch Raffle

The lunch raffle took too long. We decided to change format to having just 5-6 nice prizes instead of a large pile of smaller ones. Participants will get several tickets to "bet" towards a particular prize.

Location

Again we discussed the possibility of moving the 2005 conference to Cal State Channel Islands in Ventura to be more inclusive of those who don't live near downtown Santa Barbara, and to possibly reduce our conference costs since the catering prices at SBCC are becoming a little prohibitive.

3. Treasurer's Report

Bringing account to \$1500 balance:

We're awaiting two final large checks for the Oct. conference from SBCC and Adult Ed. With them depositined, we should have just under \$3000, but as a part of CATESOL we shouldn't have more than \$1500. We brainstormed possible uses of the extra funds. Among ideas:

- getting an impressive speaker	- buy things with chapter logo (e.g. bookmarks)	- increase the amt. to be given to CATESOL
- have a nice chapter social event	- \$200-\$300 travel award to attend CATESOL	- local conference student recognition award
- purchase AV equipment for chapter	- increase \$ for summer workshop series	- CATESOL membership for new teacher(s)

What we decided

- Give \$500 to CATESOL (our parent organization)
- Use \$250 to create a Dianne Riffle Memorial Award to give a member who has never been to a state conference the opportunity to go

(This might have to be a one-time award instead of yearly, but it still honors our former treasurer and friend.)

- Use \$250 for a chapter social event
- Earmark \$500 for our Spring/Summer Workshop Series. We'll pay \$75/hour to presenters instead of \$50/hour, as we did last year.
