Publishers

The second tier logo costs \$35; the logo is half the size of top tier. Publishers pay their fee to display their logos, then they may attend any sessions.

In response to John's information-gathering action item to help us determine how much to charge publishers, Jun Li at the OC Chapter replied that "we offered \$40 registration rate for the publishers at the virtual workshop in August. In the past, we offered \$70 for a table and \$120 for two tables for a non-virtual workshop. Therefore, we kept the \$70 registration rate for publishers who also want to be sponsors."

Randy will work with Marsha Chan to be sure the page of the CATESOL web portal has the correct information in the correct order.
